CHANG WEI MUN

Mr Chang Wei Mun was called to the Malaysian Bar on 18th November 1986 whereupon he joined the law firm of Messrs Raja, Darryl & Loh. He was admitted into partnership on January 1, 1991 and presently heads the firm's construction and energy department.

Wei Mun has been involved in the dispute resolution process with regard to construction projects involving, amongst others, international airports, hotels, commercial complexes, a water treatment plant, a petrochemical facility, oil rigs, a paper mill, a waste disposal facility, a major dam, a power station, undersea fibre optic cabling, and land reclamation works. He is the President of the Malaysian Institute of Arbitrators and was listed as a leading lawyer in the field of construction dispute resolution in Chambers ASIA 2010 and 2011.

He has acted as president, and co-arbitrator in respect of 3 member arbitral tribunals as well as sole arbitrator in various international and domestic arbitrations. Wei Mun has appeared in all levels of the Malaysian Court system where close to 30 cases which he has argued have been reported and published.

Wei Mun is a member of the panel of arbitrators of the International Chamber of Commerce, Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur Regional Centre for Arbitration, and Korean Commercial Arbitration Board. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, Malaysian Institute of Arbitrators and Singapore Institute of Arbitrators.
